Such changes would have the effect of either materially increasing the Company's involvement in such program or materially decreasing its involvement. Such resolution would have caused the information contained in MIM's Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for the quarter ended March 31, 2003 ("Form 10-Q") under the heading "Item 2. Management's Discussion and Analysis of Financial Condition and Results of Operations" of Part I to be outdated and potentially misleading. Accordingly, MIM could not file such portion of its Form 10-Q within the prescribed time period.
